2020 was a year full of extraordinary moments that required extraordinary change. Last year, Kairos staff continued to provide exceptional clinical services to the youth, young adults, and families in our care while navigating the pandemic and coping with devastating losses from the wildfires experienced in our communities.

The COVID-19 pandemic and response efforts drastically altered healthcare across the nation and forced mental health providers to evolve quickly to maintain care of those in need. This was no different for Kairos. We responded quickly to change protocols and service delivery across all programs so that the youth, young adults, and families could still receive much-needed services safely.

Having to navigate the pandemic allowed the Kairos staff to be incredibly resilient and creative in how we delivered services. The challenges we faced were significant—including a drastic reduction in revenue—and yet I could not be prouder of how staff remained creative, responsive, and focused on those we serve.

The agency remains highly committed to providing intensive mental health services to vulnerable youth and young adults. We are dedicated to finding solutions to the challenges the agency faced from COVID-19 while remaining anchored in our mission. Any support you might be able to give will help us provide lifechanging services to those who need it the most.

We need your help to continue building stronger communities that value and support mental wellness.

Kairos ended the year on a positive note! The agency's collaborative annual fundraiser, Rogue Winterfest, was a success. This virtual event netted \$114,000, to be shared equally among Family Solutions, Options for Southern Oregon, and Kairos. Thank you to everyone who contributed to the event through sponsorships, volunteering, or their artistry. It truly was a magical event. In many ways, this event mirrors the many miracles staff perform daily at Kairos. While the fundraising success of Rogue Winterfest was amazing considering the team had to pivot and host virtual events, the amount raised was less than in previous years.

Kairos has a lot to celebrate, most and foremost that the youth and families continue to receive outstanding services. This remains the one constant through all the changes, and I remain incredibly grateful to the dedicated and talented staff as well as to supportive stakeholders such as yourself.

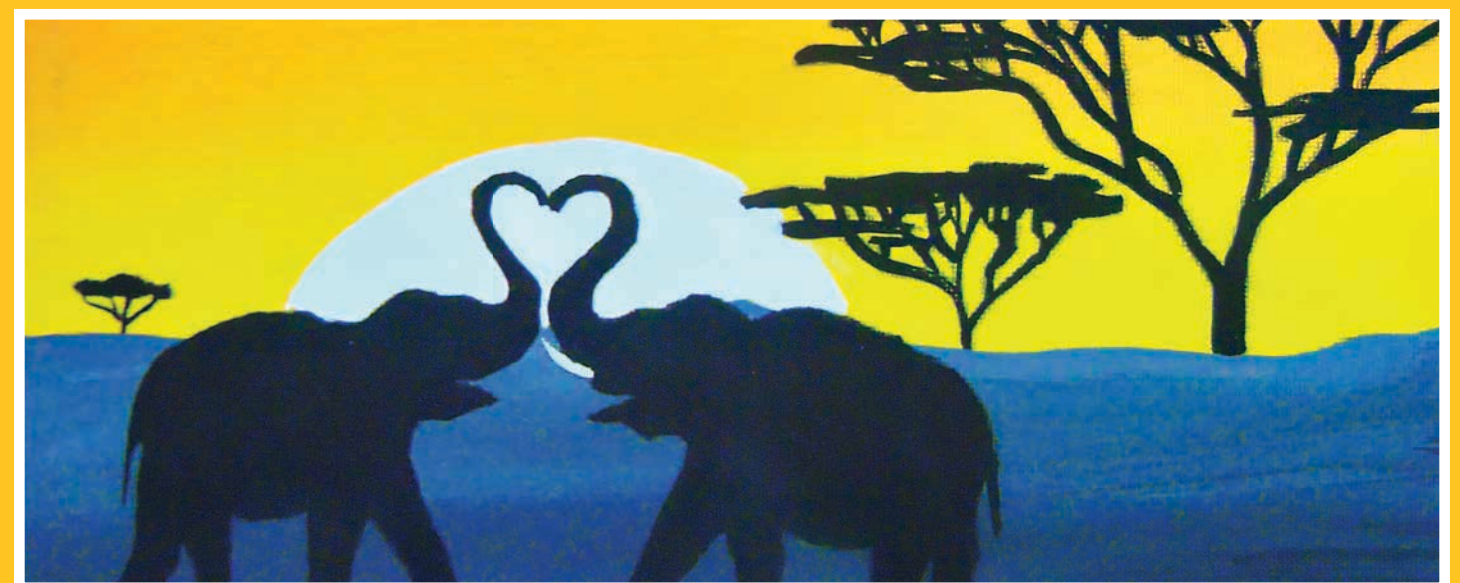
